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The Guidance Center's Early Childhood Program serves children from ages 3-7 that are experiencing behavioral or emotional issues that interfere with their relationships within family, social or educational settings. Our goal is to provide appropriate intervention at a young age so that each child can be successful at home, school and the community.

What does the Early Childhood Program offer?

- **Walk-In Assessments** to help parents identify specific areas of concern and to receive recommended services for their child.
- **Referrals to *Count Your Kid In Screenings*** with your local school district or by contacting The Guidance Center to receive further information
- **Services** that are tailored to your child's individual needs. These can be:
 - **Case Management**
 - **"S.T.A.R." Program for 3-5 year olds**
 - **Individual and Family Therapy**
 - **Medication Management**
 - **After-School and Summer Social Skills/Character Education Groups for 5-7 year olds**
 - **Respite**
 - **Attendant Care**
