Requirements for Application

- Current enrollment in a doctoral program in clinical or counseling psychology and completion of a minimum of 3 years of graduate study and in good standing
- Completed a minimum of 500 practicum hours
- Dissertation proposal must be approved by ranking deadline
- The program prefers, but does not require, that applicants be from APA accredited graduate programs in clinical or counseling psychology
- Licensure eligible in Kansas at the start of the internship year. Please see https://ksbsrb.ks.gov/ for temporary LMLP requirements.
